



Criminal Record Check

Central City Breakers FC (a.k.a CCB) is governed by BC Soccer who requires all team officials (including coaches, assistant coaches, managers) have a completed Criminal Records Check (CRC) on file with their club. A new CRC is required to be submitted every 5 years.

CCB is required to report the status of our Risk Management to BC Soccer annually on October 1st and submit regular updates. Without a completed CRC on file with your club, BC Soccer will not recognize you as a team official and you are not covered by their insurance policy.

You cannot act as team official of a 1, or 5 District League or BCCGSC, or SMSA, or SDGSA team(s) until you submit a completed CRC to our Club.

CCB strongly values the safety of its players and volunteers. Hence, the Criminal Record Check (CRC) is part of our Risk Management protocol. We will need a completed CRC on file before we can release your BC Soccer ID card which is required for all coaches & managers.

New Online eCRC Program

Good news for those of you who have not yet dropped off your CRC forms at the RCMP station! CCB is now enrolled with the BC Government's Criminal Records Review Program (CRRP) Applicant Based Online Service also referred to as eCRC.

The eCRC program satisfies BC Soccer's Risk Management requirements.

You may now apply for a CRC online, and no longer have to go to the RCMP unless fingerprints are necessary. This service is offered free to CCB's volunteers. The results of your eCRC will be emailed to ccbexecutivedirector@gmail.com.

NOTE: You will be asked question's of a personal nature to identify you to be who you are. For example: One of the coaches was asked – do you have a visa or master card? But you will not be asked to provide your credit card number. Should you answer any of the questions incorrectly, the system will ask you to get a club official to sign and verify your identity. In this case, please call club Director of Coaching & Player Development (604 219-1616), and will be happy to sign your form.

We hope that the eCRC program will make it easier for CCB's volunteers to comply with BC Soccer's Risk Management requirements.
