- The registration will be waiting till the funds are received by the club from the support agency
- A family can pay for a complete registration for the kid to start playing right away and a complete refund of \$300.00 will be issued once payment is received from the grant.
- In extreme situation CCB Football Club executive holds the right to make exceptions to this policy
- The parent or guardian will be responsible for the completion of the applications and the CCB Football Club front office staff can provide any assistance needed to complete the forms
